CAROLINE AHERNE: Overcame her alcohol problems to have us all in stitches with her brilliant comedy, *The Royle Family*.

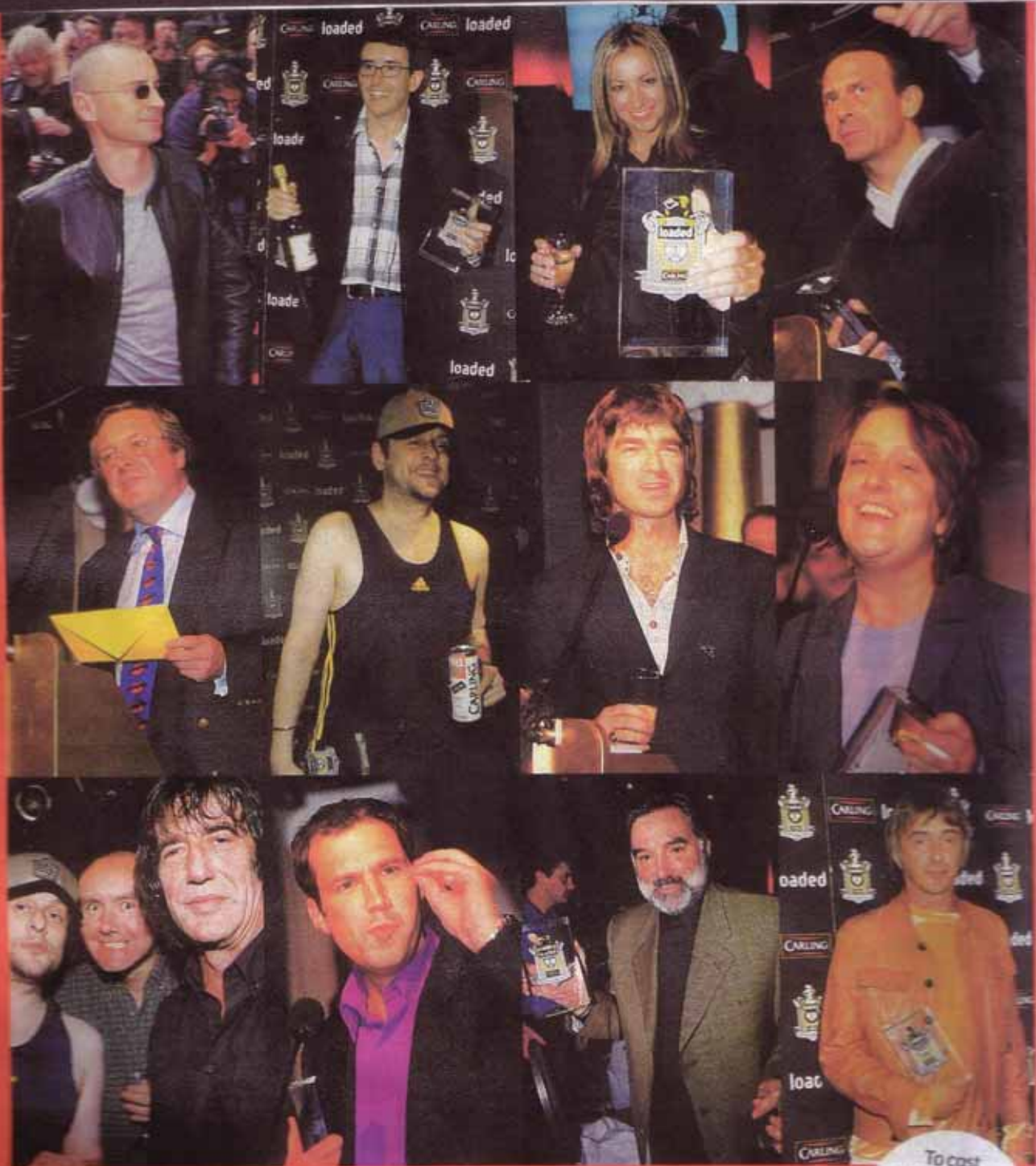
GERI HALLIWELL: After leaving the Spice Girls, Geri notched up three Number Ones in the last year.

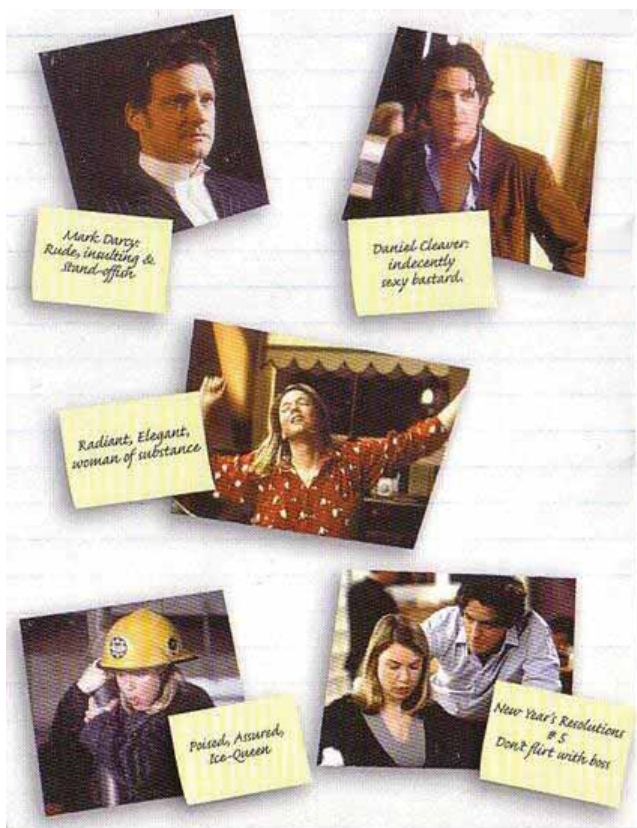
